

Good Evening, Everyone!

I am sharing the below bullets that highlight current opportunities around contact tracing. I am also including our guidance document on the volunteer process, as well.

- Thank you for your interest in assisting the Pennsylvania Department of Health with its efforts to combat COVID-19. Contact Tracing is one of the most important roles in the Commonwealth's efforts to Reopen Pennsylvania. We are currently seeking contact tracers who represent trusted messengers in each community.
- PA DOH is exploring paid opportunities across the commonwealth, and the Allegheny County Health Department is working through onboarding any positions it had posted. We will update partners on paid positions as they become available.
- For now individuals can volunteer their services through Pennsylvania's online registry for medical and non-medical volunteers found here at [SERVPA \(http://www.serv.pa.gov\)](http://www.serv.pa.gov).
- The Department is seeking individuals who speak additional languages and who may have experience in working within local communities or with specialized/targeted populations such as faith leaders, service providers within the homeless community, providers who work with individuals living with disabilities, and individuals from other vulnerable communities.
- Volunteer opportunities will afford individuals the opportunity to provide service to their local community and state in the fight against COVID, while offering a new skillset and potential pathway into public health work or future efforts.
- Volunteers with availability beyond 15 hours per week have been prioritized in the onboarding process, but as we develop our internal infrastructure at DOH- we will be working to onboard volunteers with more limited availability.
