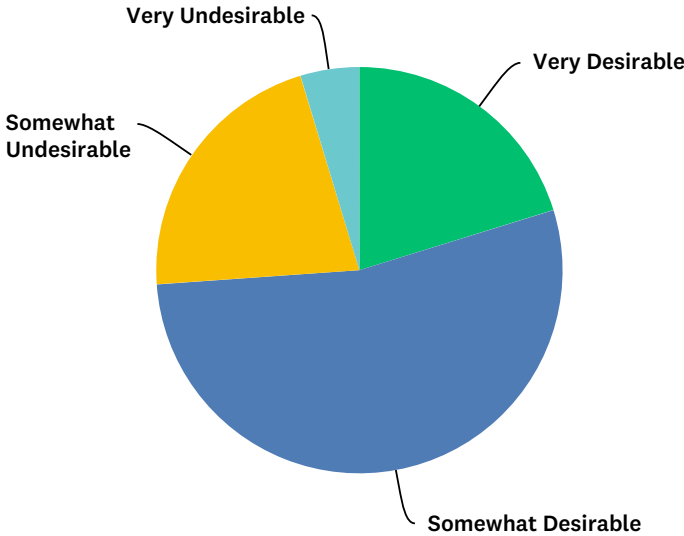


Q1 We would like to begin by asking how you feel about Indiana County as a place to live. Do you consider it:

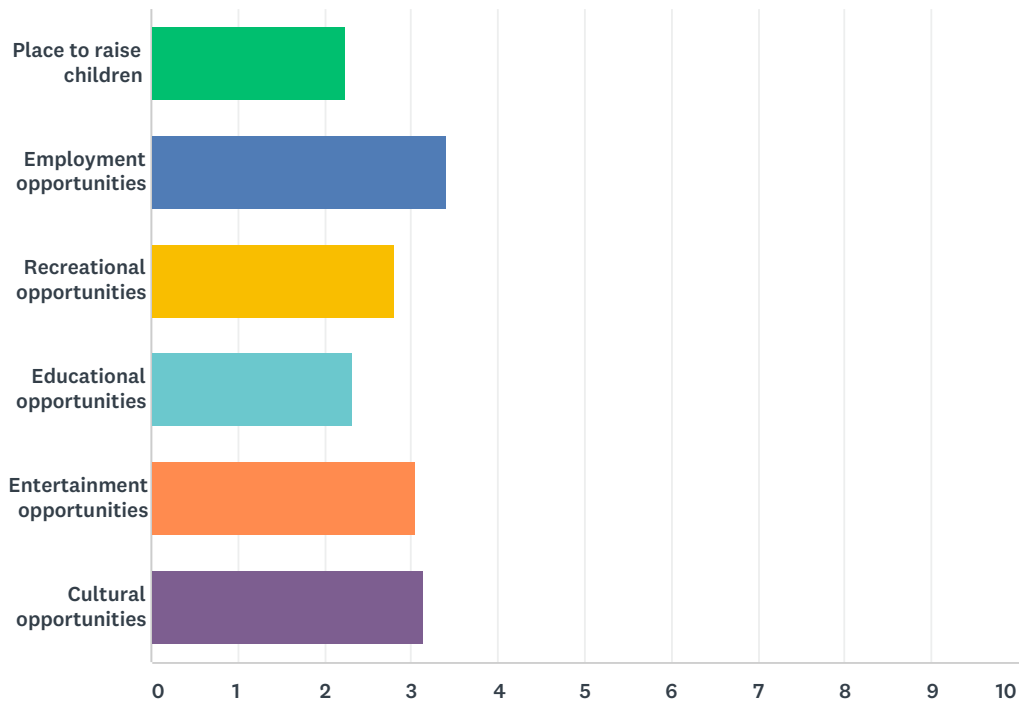

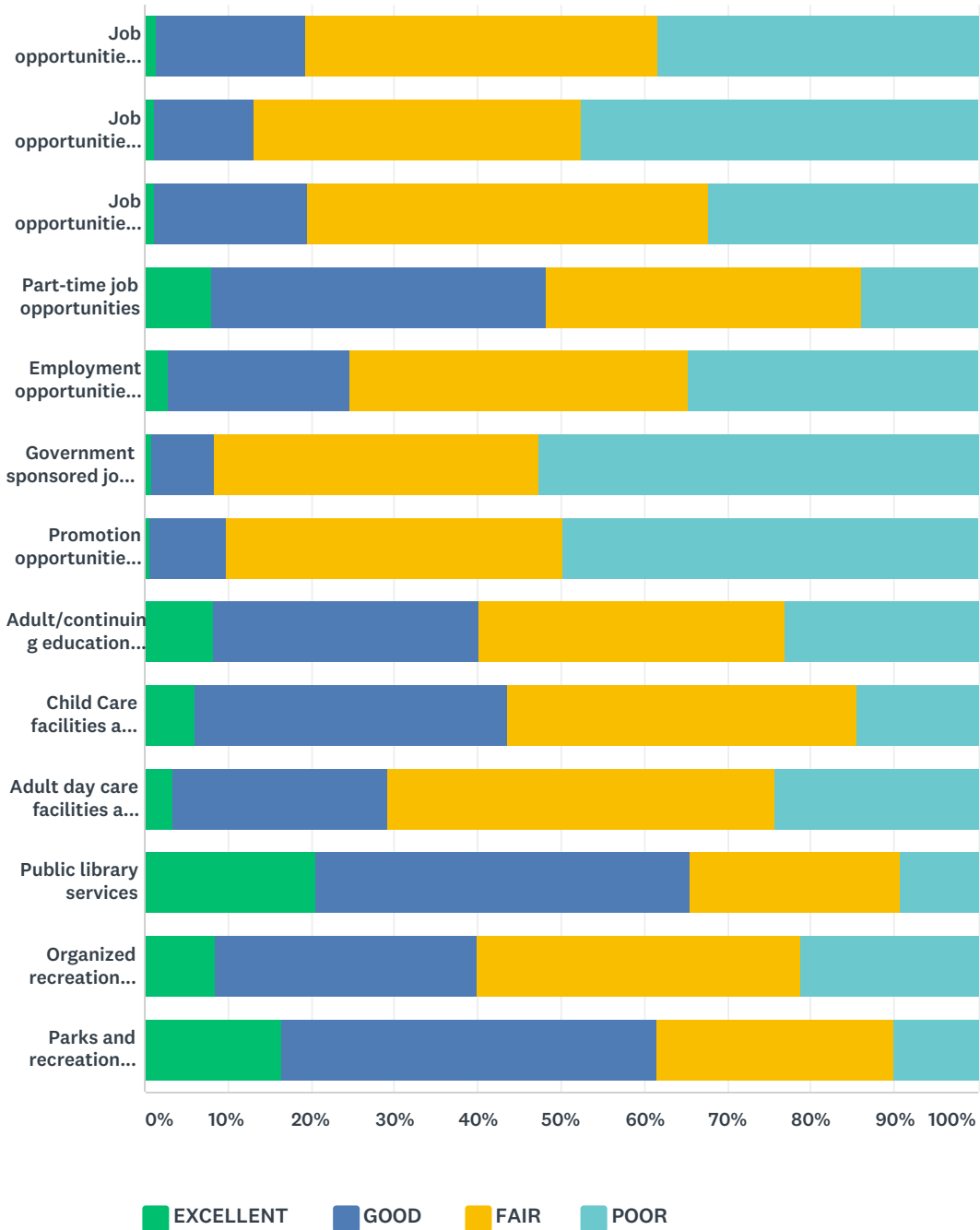

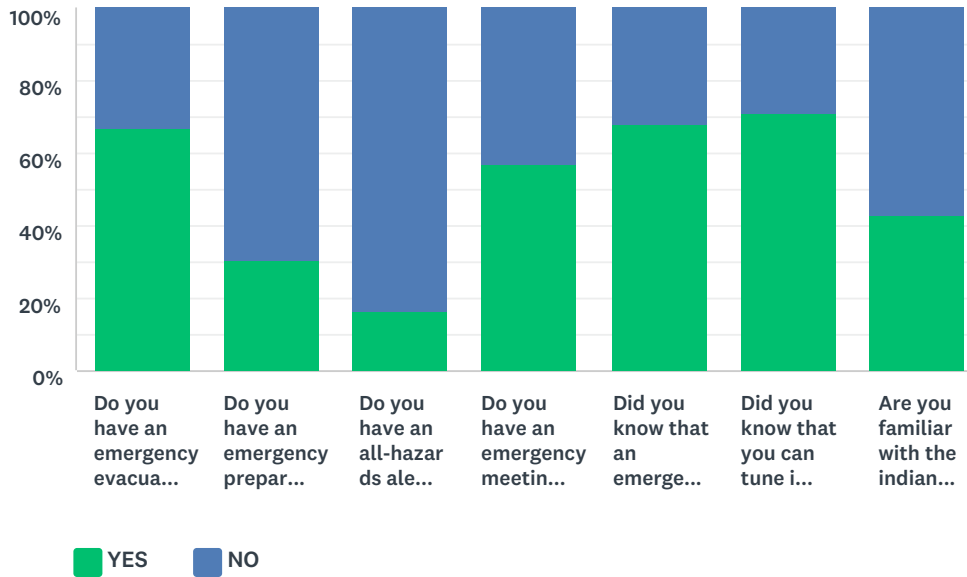

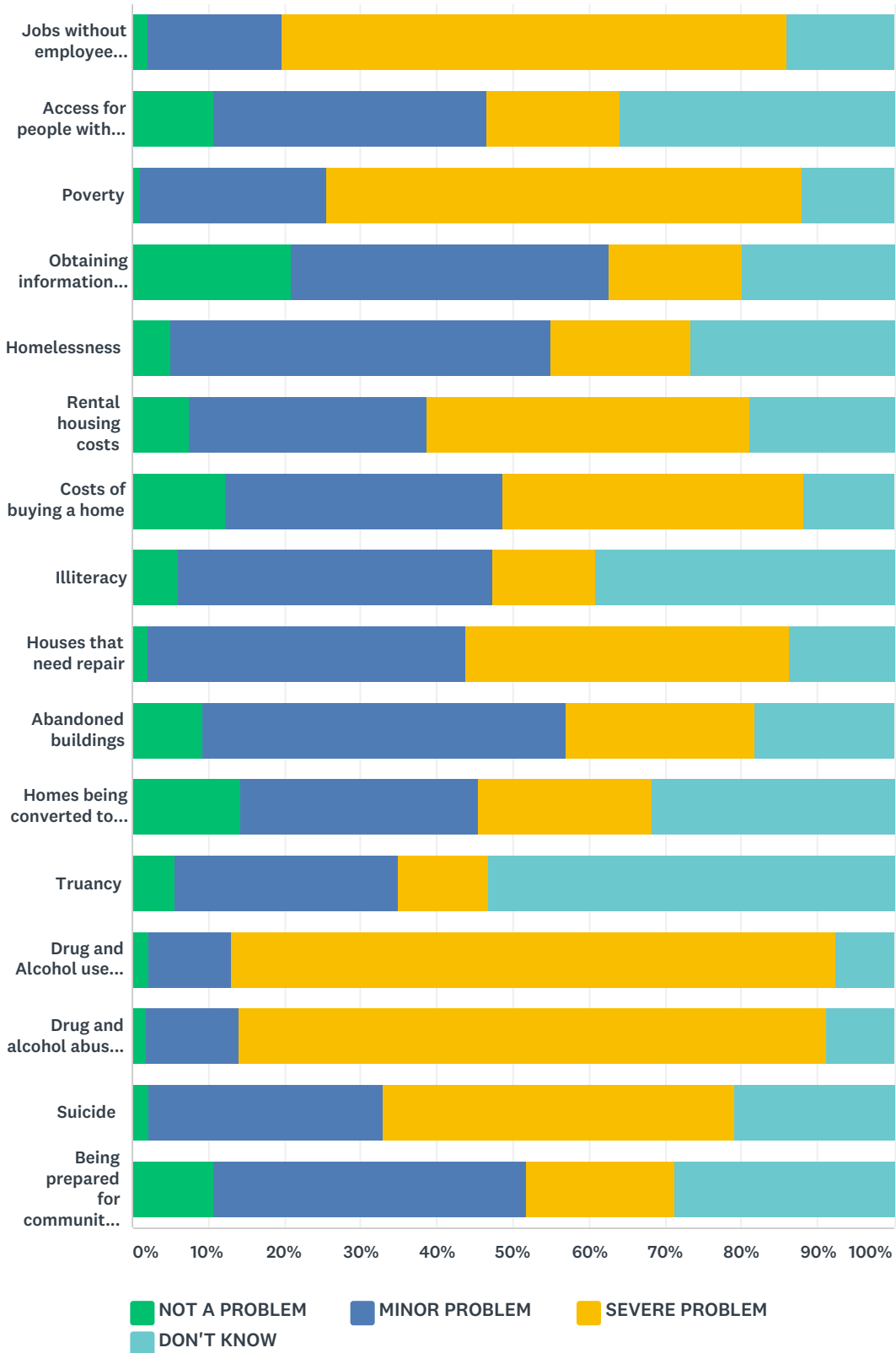

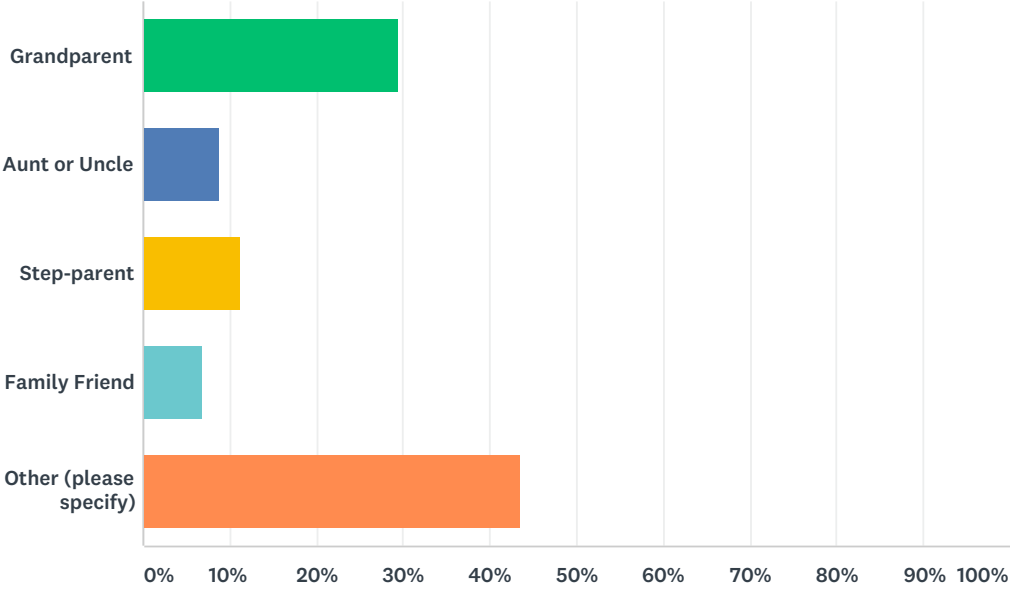

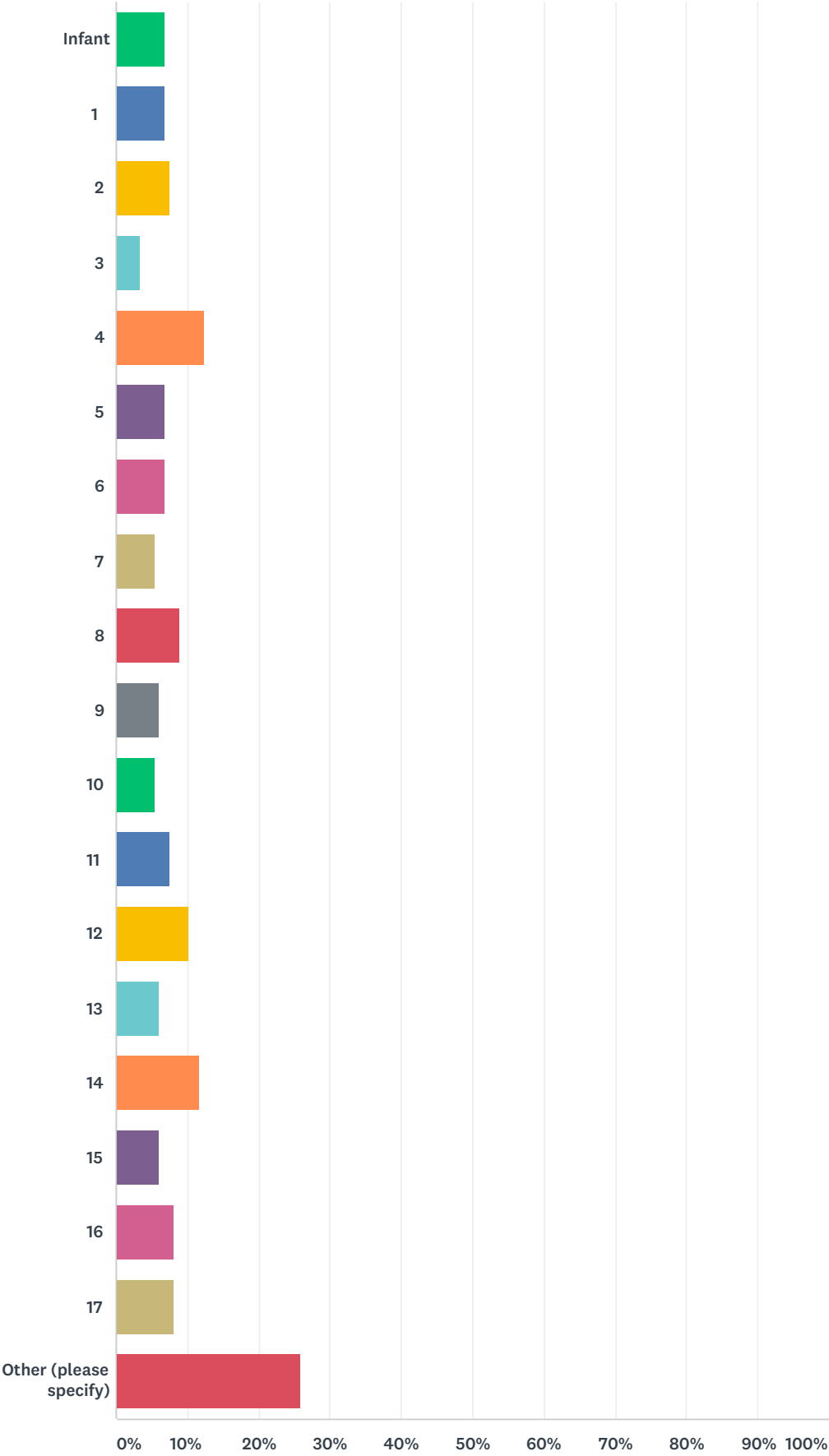

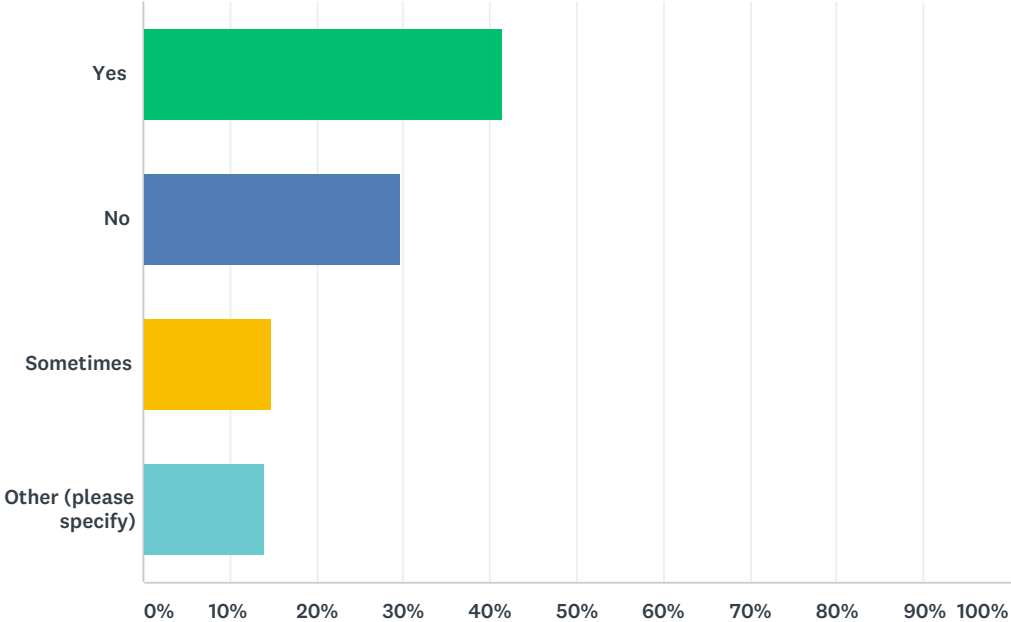

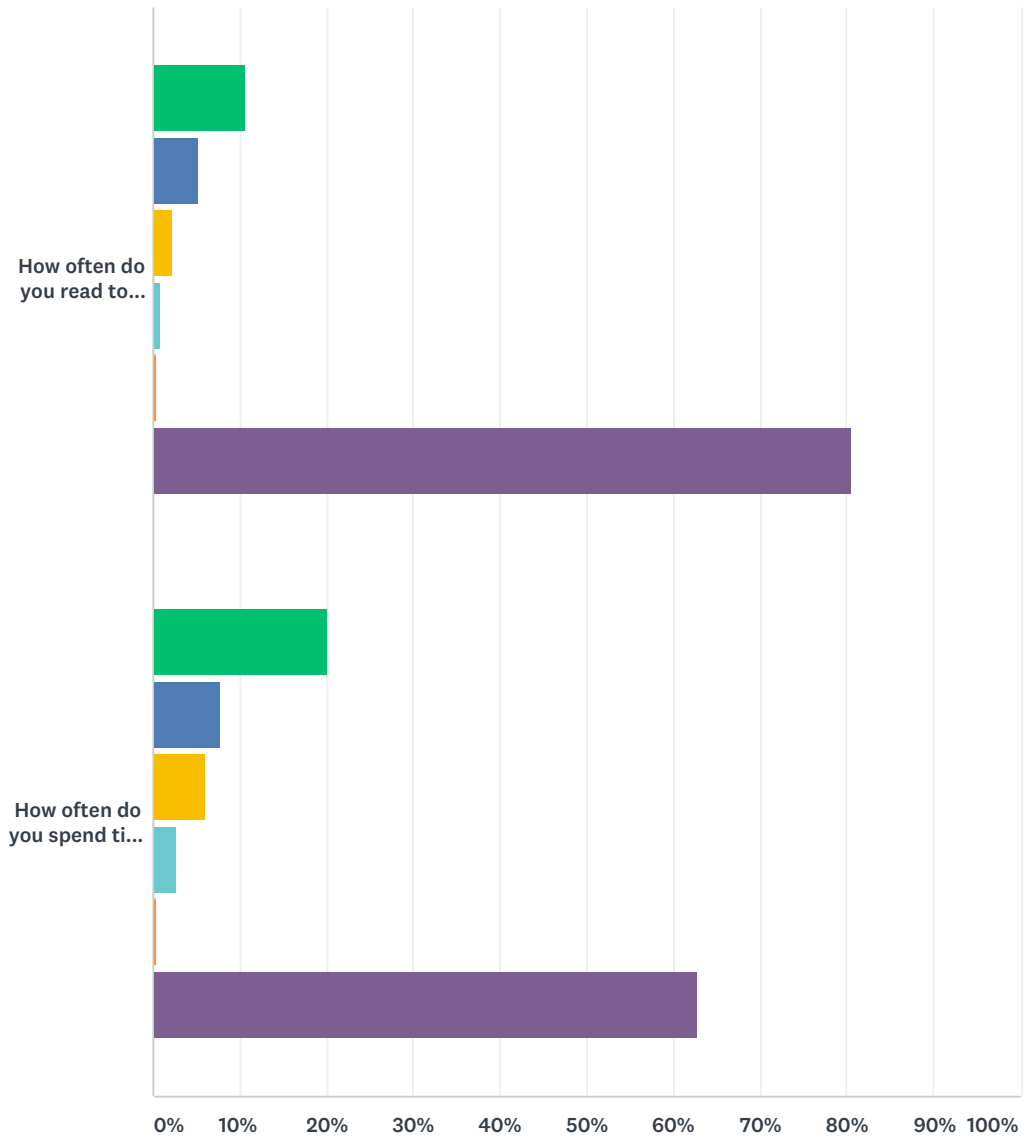

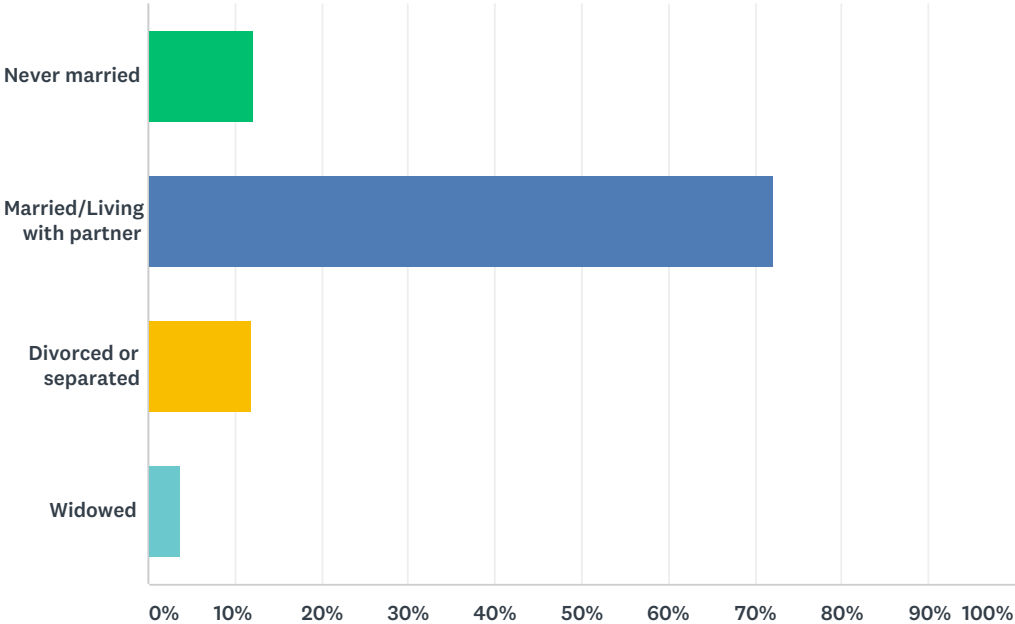

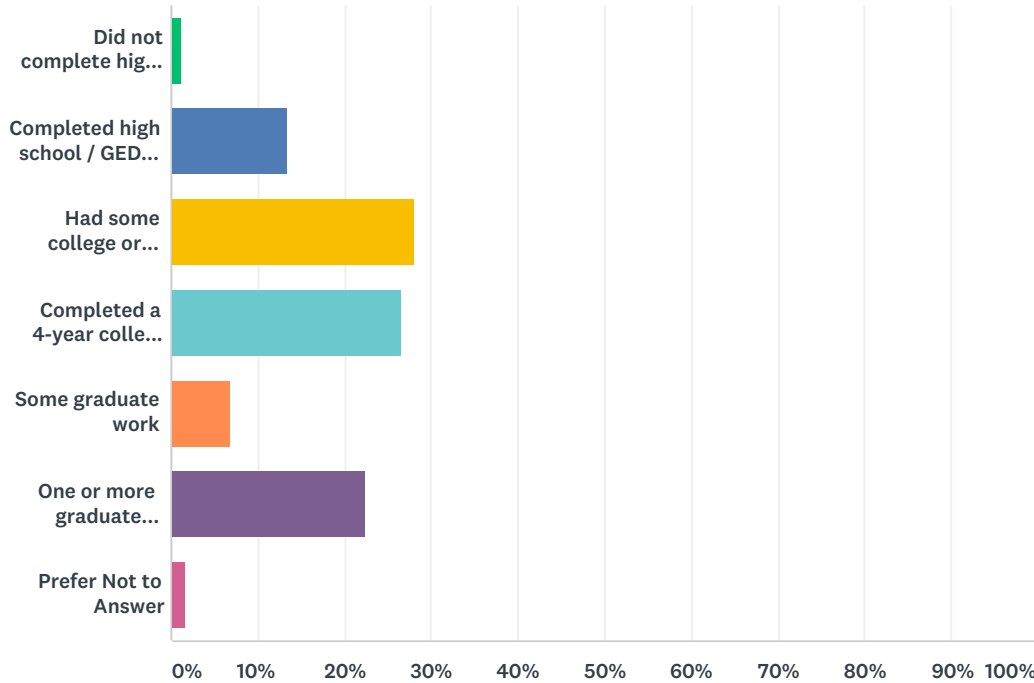

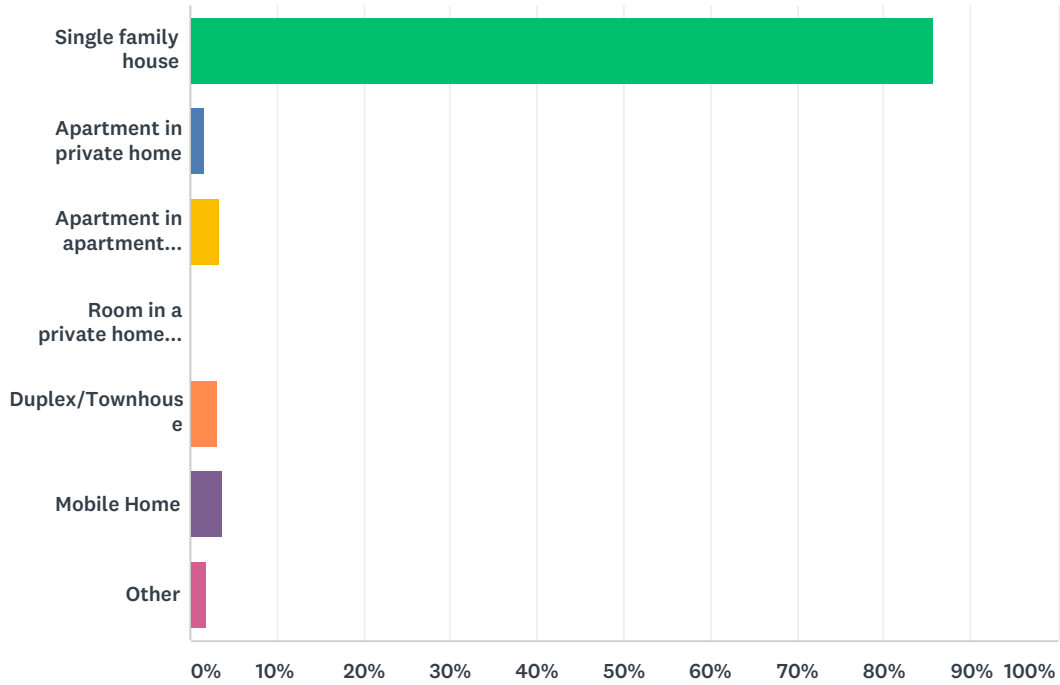

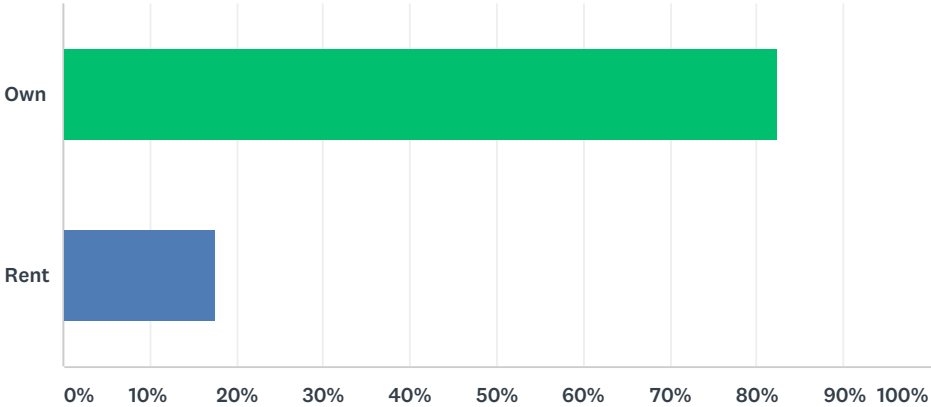

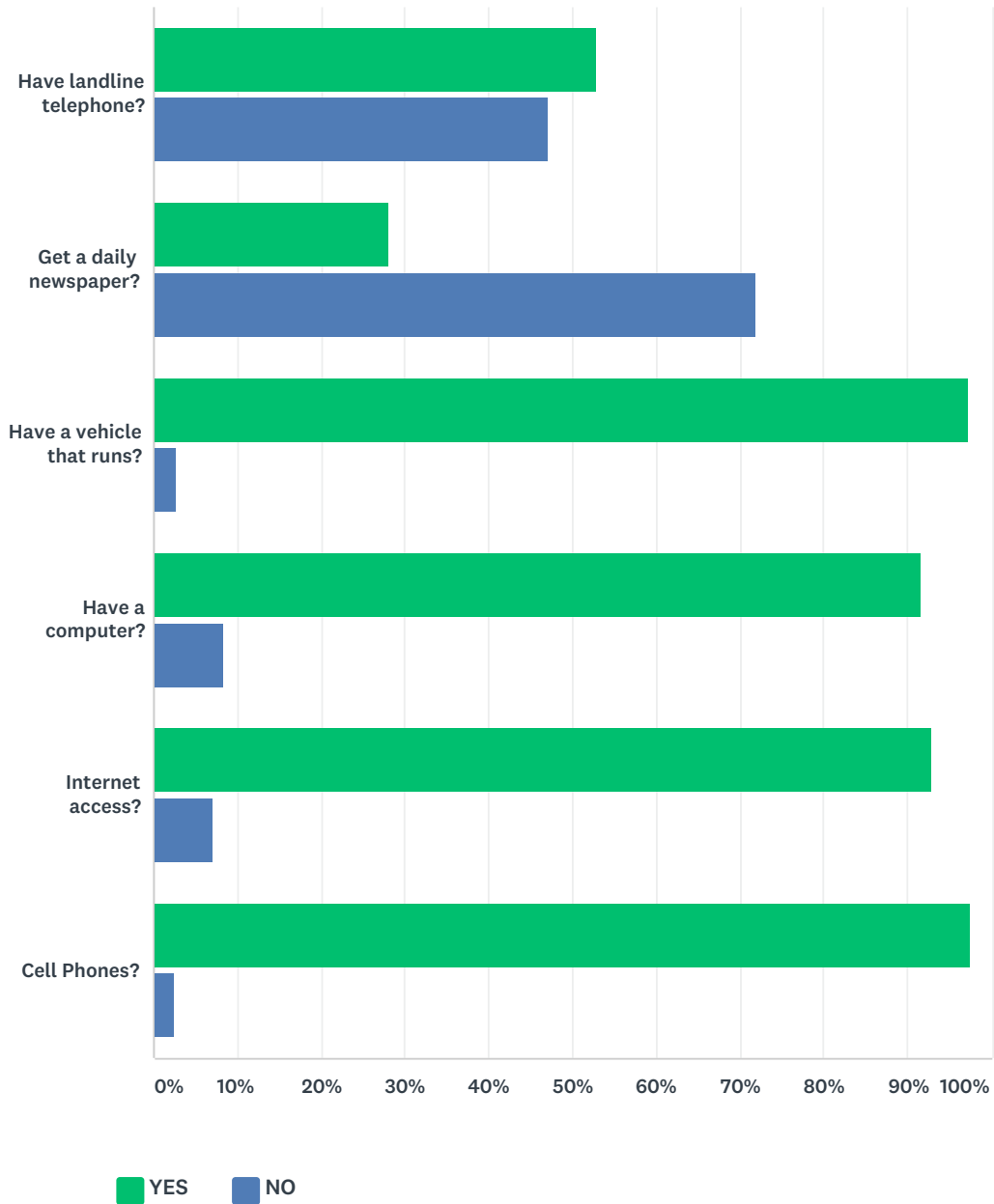

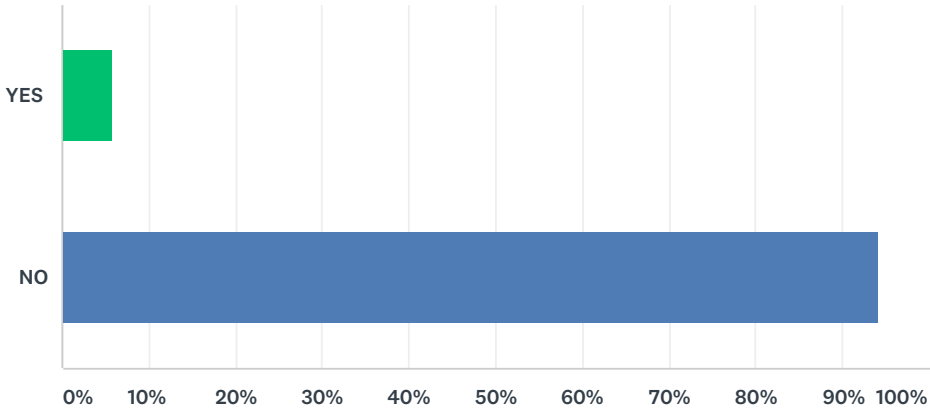

Q32 Do you have a disability that prevents you from doing your own daily living activities?

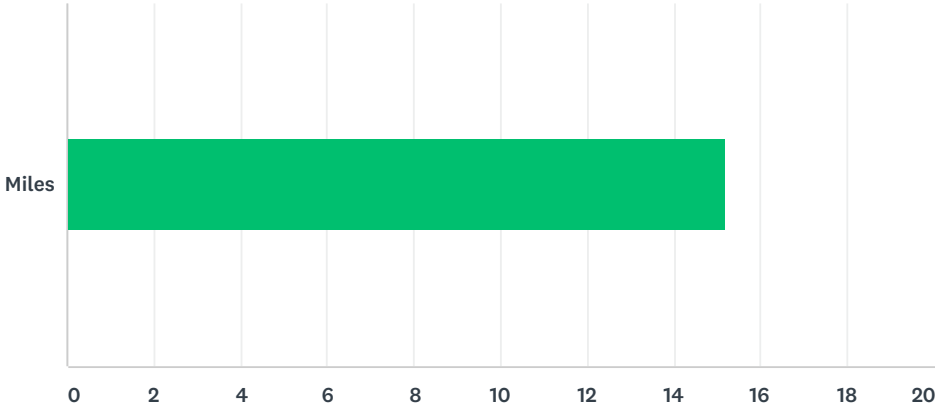

Q33 How far (one way) do you travel to get to your primary job?

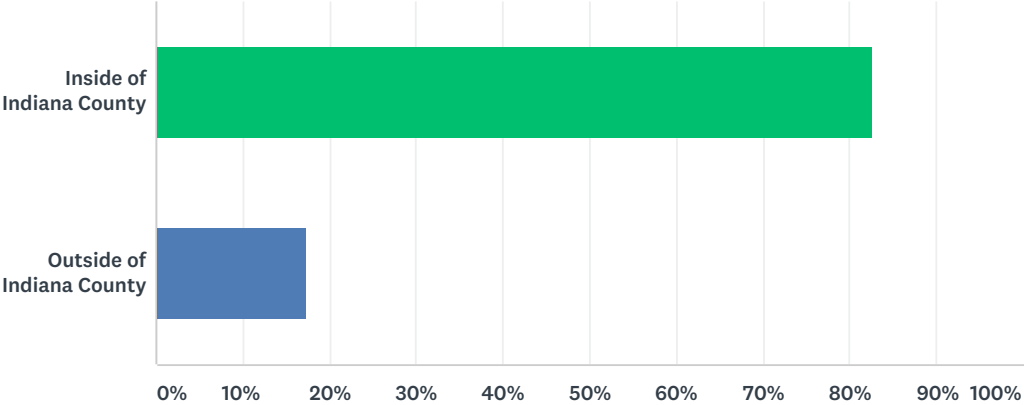

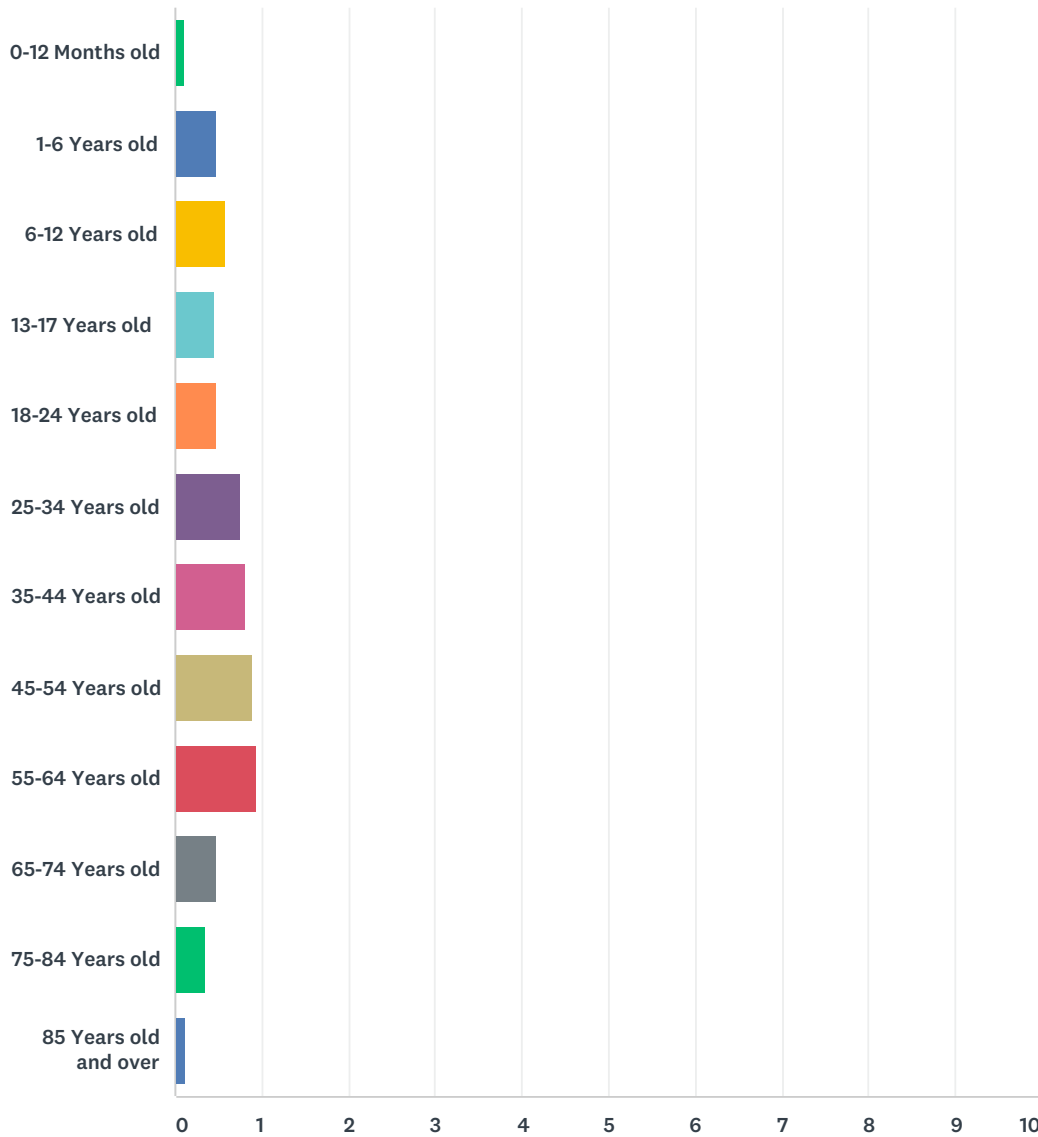
