**Indiana, PA** – Troopers are reminding residents to check on their neighbors, especially those who may be isolated or vulnerable. A simple phone call may serve to brighten a neighbor's spirits and provide a sense of community and reassurance within your neighborhood.

Troopers also wish to remind residents that if they are concerned about welfare of a friend, family member or neighbor, our members can conduct a Welfare Check or refer the request to the law enforcement agency with primary jurisdiction. Since March 1, the members of Troop A have conducted a total of 2,334 Welfare Checks across Cambria, Indiana, Somerset and Westmoreland counties with the most recent request being received at 1:25 a.m. today.
