WHAT IS AN FOHC?

A Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), more commonly known as a Community Health Center (CHC), is a primary care center that is community-based and patient directed. FQHCs provide preventive services to vulnerable populations that would otherwise not have access to certain healthcare services, although all are welcome. CHCs welcome low-income individuals, the uninsured and underinsured, immigrants, migrant and seasonal farm workers, those who are homeless, and those who live in public housing.





WHO IS PRIMARY HEALTH NETWORK?

Primary Health Network began as one small community health center site in 1984. After 35 years of service, Primary Health Network has grown to become the largest FQHC in Pennsylvania and one of the largest in the nation. Each year we reach over 80,000 patients through our health and educational services. These patients can receive care from one of our 50 sites in 16 counties in Pennsylvania and one county in Ohio.

SLIDING FEE DISCOUNT SCALE

Primary Health Network accepts all patients, regardless of their insurance or financial status. Primary Health Network is a Federally Qualified Health Center, which in turn allows us to offer a wide range of services to patients through the Sliding Fee Discount Scale. We offer the Sliding Fee Discount Scale to all income-eligible uninsured or underinsured patients, based on annual household income for most of our services.



ENHANCING ACCESS TO CARE

We take great pride in implementing innovative programs and technologies to enhance access to care.

Since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, PHN has been committed to providing uninterrupted care to our patients. We want to assure you that our health centers are among the safest places one can visit. However, we understand that now, more than ever, our patients require greater convenience in care, which is why we have expanded telehealth services throughout our network, allowing for patients to connect to our healthcare services from the comfort of their own home.

To further support our underserved patients, we also have a team of Community Health Workers that address various social determinants of health, such as food insecurity and lack of transportation. Our expansion of care also includes extended hours and expanded services.
